This program uses a Bimanual Therapy protocol, with a focus on improving the ability to spontaneously coordinate both hands together through repetitive practice of carefully chosen, goal-oriented, two-handed activities.

Camp activities include games, art projects, outings, sensory play activities, and self-care. Children will be evaluated at the beginning and end of camp to measure progress in strength, exibility, and use of the a ected arm.

A physician referral/prescription is required to participate in the camp. Participants must have an insurance policy that will cover group therapy.
